b) Academic and career background: nature of theological stance, experience in continuing education, professional experience, record of performance.

c) Skills and abilities: in church administration, interpreting and promoting the connectional giving system, leadership development, worship and liturgy, preaching and evangelism, teaching and nurturing, counseling and group work, ability to work in cooperation, ability in self-evaluation, and other relational skills.

d) Community context: the ability of the pastor to relate effectively to his or her community setting, such as rural, town, urban, suburban, and so forth.

e) Family situation: health and educational needs of the family and the spouse's career.

f) Open itineracy as defined in paragraph 430.1: how can you help fulfill this denominational commitment?

g) Your reported membership (evangelism) record in last three charges served:
