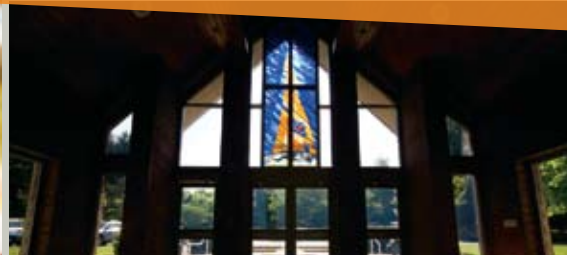

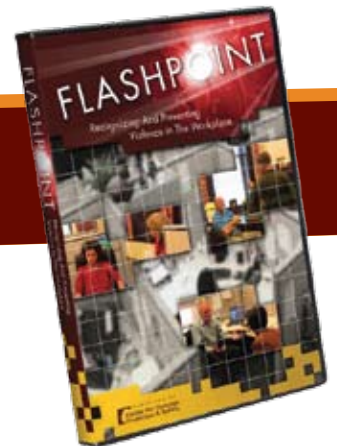

## KEYNOTE SPEAKERS:

### Robert Johnson

Bob Johnson serves as the Director of Safety and Security for Christ's Church of the Valley in Phoenix, AZ, directing over 100 staff and volunteers on this 105 acre campus. Mr. Johnson actively works with many churches both in Arizona and throughout the country to help develop and train safety and security teams. He has over 42 years of active involvement in both Public and Private Sector Security. His past work experience includes 20 years in the Arizona Army National Guard, reaching the rank of Command Sergeant Major, and overseeing leadership and management training for the Arizona Military Academy. During 10 of his 23 years with the Phoenix Police Department, Mr. Johnson was a detective with the Organized Crime Bureau. He became proficient in complex multi-agency investigations, working side by side with the FBI, IRS, Secret Service, DEA and other agencies to infiltrate and unravel many state and federal crimes.

### Jerry McConnell

Rev McConnell is the director of Ministry Outreach for the Center for Personal Protection and Safety and brings over 35 years of experience in pastoral ministry as a Youth Pastor, Associate Pastor, and Senior Pastor from 1975 to present. His background and experience includes the US Military from 1971-1974 where he traveled extensively throughout Central Europe. He also was a school teacher and coach, from 1974 -1975. Rev McConnell served as a Youth Pastor and Executive Pastor in Kirkland, WA from 1975-1986, and as a Senior Pastor in Gooding, ID, Baker City, OR and in Spokane, WA from 1986 to 2007. He has held Interim Pastor Assignments from 2008 - to present. He currently serves on the American Society for Industrial Security (ASIS) "Houses of Worship" Security Council.
