Business

Circles™ - Susan Hunt gave a overview of the [Circles™](#) program. The plan is to partner with [Move The Mountain](#) and [Spiritual Leadership, Inc \(SLI\)](#). The General Board of Global Ministries is interested in a conference being a pilot program for Circles™. Susan has been talking to GBGM about our conference. The Dothan District Incubator Group is interested in partnering/working with Susan and Circles™. A name has been presented to be the director of this program. SLI and Move The Mountain would do the training.

We are at a place to seek approval to allocate funds. We have money available from 2010 that affords the opportunity to begin the Circles™ program. We will solicit community and business partners as well. Discussion was held on whether or not said monies could be distributed instead to the agencies; over and above what was voted on them receiving at the last CORE team meeting in November. Question was raised, do you allocate these monies to agencies who are already meeting the needs of the poor or do you use said monies to start a new kind of ministry to the poor. Susan Hunt is working with the agency directors to help them grow in their leadership of the agencies. If we were to allocate these monies available to the agencies over and above what was given to them, it would be a one time distribution and not be sustained.

Several members of the CORE Team see Circles™ as a one-time opportunity to start this new ministry, the purpose of which is to break the cycle of poverty.

Discussion was also held on making sure that we give the Circles™ program long enough to work and be successful.

Susan has met with families in a circle in Pensacola of persons engaged in the program. Bishop and Mrs. Leeland have personally met with individuals who have been engaged in the Circles™ program as well.

Larry Bryars moved to approve \$100,000 for Circles™. Sam Williams second the motion. The motion was approved.
