

AL-WFL Board of Higher Education & Campus Ministry
AUM WF Presentation & Decision
November 29, 2016

The meeting began with a presentation from the leaders of The Source about their experience with college students at their church, and their belief that AUM could sustain a Wesley Foundation.

Following the presentation, the board members present met to discuss the sustainability and need for a Wesley Foundation on AUM's campus and to decide what the next steps would be.

A motion was granted to invite Neil McDavid to be part in the discussion.

After some discussion a motion was made to plant a Wesley Foundation at AUM based on the presentation of Bessie and the input from the AUM members. 1st- _____; 2nd- Bill ; it passed unanimously.

Scott distributed some handouts outlining the steps needed to achieve status as a new Campus Ministry within the conference. Scott let us know that we are on steps 3,4 & 5.

The next step is answering the questions, which Scott sent out via email to the board, Bessie and Elvyn. A preliminary board should be set up to help answer those questions and serve as a preliminary Board of Advisors. The proposed members were Brad and Joel (both from AUM), Bessie, Elvyn, Joe Williams, Jenni Hendrix, and additional members to be selected by Bessie and Elvyn.
